

TRACK EVENT PROCEDURE

- ❶ Announcer to call competitors to the Marshall area for their event.
- ❷ Mr Mason will organise students in lanes. 80m/100m and 200m races as per program. Family team lanes - Agnes lanes 1 & 2, Clare lanes 3 & 4, Francis lanes 5 & 6 and Rufino lanes 7 & 8. Award students a participation point and record on Family Team points sheet. Send students Check starter.
- ❸ Mr Taylor will raise a Red flag at the start of each race. When Mr McDonald raises a White flag indicated that the timekeepers / judges are ready, the race will start. Remind students to **RUN IN THEIR OWN LANE.**
- ❹ Mr Torenbeek (1st), Bernadette Judd (2nd), Mrs Y Colquhoun (3rd) and Ms K Parkes (4th) will judge 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place-getters and record times using multi-lane timer and plungers. Students remain in their own lane once race is completed. Judges stand in the lane of the students who finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Hand out finishing pegs. Students finishing 1st will receive a blue peg, 2nd a red peg, 3rd a green peg and 4th a yellow peg. Only the first 4 place-getters need to be timed. Mr McDonald (Chief Judge) will advise on any disputes.
- ❺ Mr McDonald will tear off race time print out and attach to recording sheet.
- ❻ MY student will lead 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place-getters to the recording desk with the recording sheet.
- ❼ Ms M. Quinney will record the names of the place getters for track events and award ribbons for all events.
- ❽ Mrs Lock will receive this information and correlate points to determine Age Champions and the winning Family Team.

RELAY PROCEDURE

- ❶ Announcer to call competitors to the marshall area for their events.
- ❷ Mr Mason will organise students into lanes in their Family teams, i.e. Agnes lane 1, Clare lane 3, Francis lane 5 and Rufino lane 7. There will be no participation points for relays.
- ❸ Mr Mason will send runners 2 & 4 from each Family team to Mr Watkins (Agnes), Mr Tierney (Clare), Ms McSweeny (Francis) and Mr Cashman (Rufino) who will be located at the opposite end to the starter. Mr McDonald will confirm with Mr Taylor and when ready, start the race.
- ❹ Mr Torenbeck (1st), Mrs Judd (2nd), Mrs Colquhoun (3rd) and Ms K Parkes (4th) will judge 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place-getters and record time of 1st place only. Hand out finishing pegs. Students finishing 1st will receive a blue peg, 2nd a red peg, 3rd a green peg and 4th a yellow peg.
- ❺ Mr McDonald will tear off race time print out and attach to recording sheet.
- ❻ MY student will lead 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place-getters to the recording desk with the recording sheet.
- ❼ Mrs Stapleton/Ms Quinney will award ribbons to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place-getters. Ribbons are awarded to each competitor, i.e. 4 ribbons for first, 4 ribbons for second etc.
- ❽ Mrs Lock will receive this information and correlate points to determine the winning family team.
