St Bonaventure joined the order of Franciscans in 1243 and was recognised for his intellectual talents. He was sent to study in Paris where he taught and preached for many years. He was a contemporary of St Thomas Aquinas and in 1257, Bonaventure was elected as the head of the Franciscans.

St Bonaventure wrote important works in theology, philosophy and mysticism, and was declared a doctor of the church in 1958. He was also regarded for his compassion and gentle nature and for his accessibility to those who sought him. He has since been considered the greatest friar since St Francis of Assisi himself.

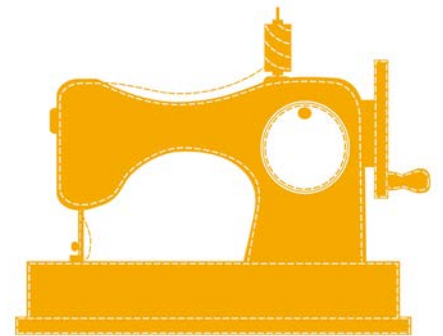
We will recognise our debaters on assembly once the season is finished.

Athletics Training

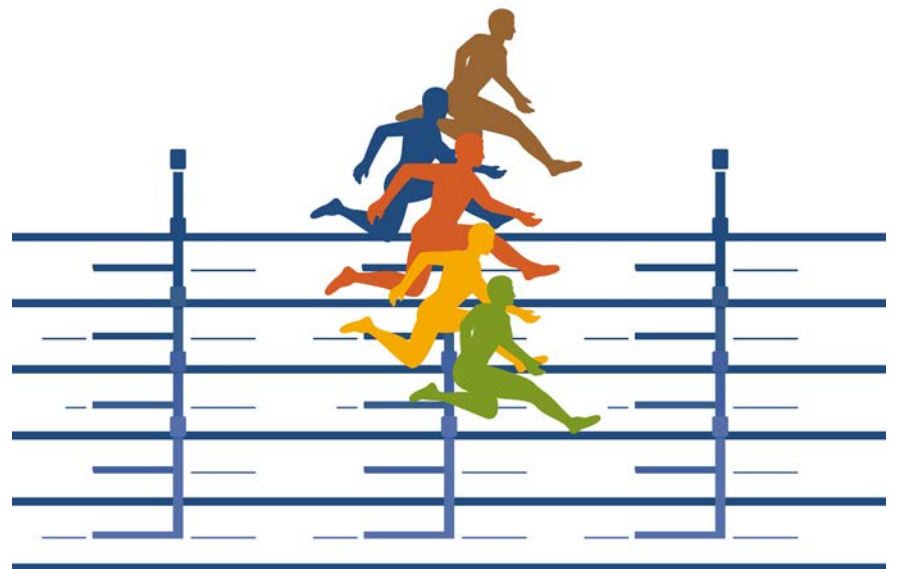
Athletics training has started again with all Middle & Senior Years students invited to attend Monday & Tuesday mornings from 7:30am. Please meet on Secondo.
