Middle Years English Tutoring will take place every Thursday morning before school in Cortona from 8.15am to 8.45am. Tutoring will commence in Week 2.

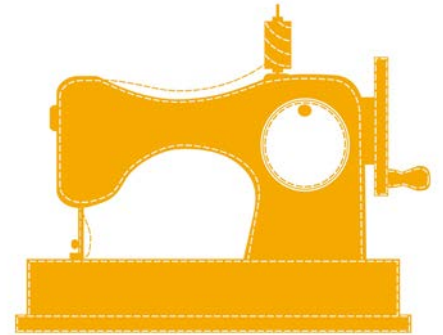
