Priority 1: Mission and Religious Education

We intend to:

- Complete construction of a contemporary Religious Education / Spirituality Centre at Assisi
- Mark our 10th year with the inclusion of significant Franciscan icons to enhance our Pope Francis Centre
- Implement the new BCE Religious Education Curriculum Framework from Preparatory to Year 12
- Continue to explore options for a contemporary Religious Education Leadership structure that reflects our commitment to being an authentic Catholic College

Priority 2: Learning and Teaching

We intend to:

- Continue our P – 6 Reading Program to improve learning outcomes for our students by monitoring, tracking and providing differentiated learning through programs such as “Words Their Way”
- Plan for the introduction of Phase 2 ACARA subjects in 2015
- Review our Responsible Behaviour Program to reflect BCE Student Behaviour Support guidelines
- Continue to provide staff with the knowledge and skills required to deliver contemporary learning through the effective use of digital pedagogies in a P – 12 1:1 learning and teaching environment
- Continue to skill staff in the use of MOODLE as the College’s LMS
- Establish a feedback culture at Assisi with the goal of “Helping Teachers to Be the Best they Can Be”

Priority 3: Professional Practices and Collaborative Relationships

We intend to:

- Implement programs that develop a strong culture of positive education based on Martin Seligman’s “Positive Psychology”
- Collaboratively develop a Middle Leadership structure that best supports our educational vision
- To celebrate, in fine style, the contributions of all members of the Assisi community to the significant achievements of the past 10 years

- To allocate resources for a variety of building projects to complete all aspects of the College Master Plan
