- Is linked to The Federation of Parents and Friends Associations of Catholic Schools Qld
- Follows all relevant and required guidelines and procedures
- Has an executive membership that is formed constitutionally
- · Meets regularly through the school year
- Advertises its meetings and conducts orderly, effective and timely meetings and
