## STUDENT UNIFORM CODE

1. The correct uniform is to be worn at the College, travelling between home and College and on other occasions as required. For Senior Years, the College blazer is required to be worn to and from the College on all school days between Mother's Day and Father's Day.
2. Any deviations from the Uniform Code are to be explained in writing: to the Classroom Teacher (EY/JY); or by a note signed by parents and countersigned by the Pastoral Co-ordinator (MY/SY).
3. All items of uniform should be clearly and permanently marked.
4. The College hat is to be worn at all times, except when inside classrooms or the Student Administration Office.
5. College shoes are to be kept clean and polished.
6. Sports uniform is to be worn on sports days (all precincts) and during HPE/Core PE/Futsal classes (MY/SY).
7. Competition sports uniforms are only to be worn at inter-school competitions. Sports shorts must be worn to school. Students change into competition uniforms.
8. Family Team shirts are to be worn to major College events, such as the sporting Carnivals, Assisi Day, Spirituality Days and Graduation Assembly. Students will receive notification of when they are to wear their Family Team shirts before an upcoming event.
9. If a student is timetabled for a practical subject such as Science, ITD or Food Technology, the College formal shoe is to be worn for that lesson.
10. Appropriate dress will be required in specialist rooms, details of which will be provided by the departments concerned.
11. Free dress days, including Book Week, must be of appropriate attire. No midriffs, singlets or offensive messages on clothing are to be worn. Shorts and skirts need to be of appropriate length as per College sports shorts.

## SHOES

### SUITABLE SHOES:

Year Prep

#### FOR PREP STUDENTS ONLY:

Black sports shoes (Velcro) - Black leather shoes preferred. Shoes may have some black mesh.



Years 1 - 12

#### FOR DAY:

Traditional, formal black leather lace-up shoes with a supported heel.  
*(no joggers, Vans, canvas, suede, skate shoes, Dunlop Volleys, etc.)*



#### FOR SPORT:

Black, lace-up joggers. Joggers may have some black mesh.  
*(no Vans, canvas, suede, skate shoes, Dunlop Volleys, etc.)*

## COSMETICS


- Makeup, if worn, must be of lightest coverage and natural finish.
- Mascara, false eyelashes and coloured nail polish are not permitted.
- Students will be required to remove make-up (if not light and natural), false eyelashes and nail polish.
- Long, false nails are not permitted and will be required to be cut short.

# HAIR

Parents and students are reminded that students are to always maintain a clean and tidy appearance. Extreme haircuts (including beading, undercuts, tracks, patterns and mullets) and/or colours are not consistent with our uniform standards. If students have their hair cut, styled or coloured in an unacceptable fashion, they will not attend classes – as determined by the College. If students are contemplating a doubtful course of action in this matter, they would be wise to check with a teacher.

## FOR BOYS

- Very short haircuts (less than gauge 1) or very long hair is not acceptable.
- There should be smooth transition and no noticeable difference in hair length.
- Fade must conform to the shape of the head, no less than gauge 1.
- Hair must be above the eyebrows, collars, and off the face.
- Must be clean shaven at all times.
- Hair must not be tied up or in a bun.
- No tracks/shaved lines, undercuts, mullets, mohawks, burst fades, horseys, rat's tails etc.
- The below images show examples of hairstyles that are considered unacceptable:



## FOR GIRLS

- Very short haircuts (less than gauge 1) are not acceptable.
- Hair collar length or longer must be tied back.
- Hair ribbons and headbands are to be navy, white, grey or gold and of narrow width.
- Hair must be out of eyes.
- Hair must be off the face. No tracks/shaved lines.

## JEWELLERY

- Jewellery is not permitted while students are in College uniform, with the exception of a watch or small religious cross/crucifix on a chain. Girls may also wear very plain gold or silver sleepers or small studs, one per lower ear lobe. Stones and pearls are not acceptable. Sleepers cannot exceed 5 mm from the bottom of the ear lobe.
- No visible body piercings are permitted except for a single lower lobe ear piercing for females.
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or studs.
- Piercings cannot be covered by protective materials e.g. band-aids, clear and hairstyles.

## SKIRT LENGTH

To maintain a professional and comfortable environment, skirts should be worn just above the knee or longer. This adjustment ensures our dress code remains consistent and respectful for everyone.

## TATTOOS

No tattoos permitted. If a student does not adhere to these expectations, students and parents will be required to have a meeting regarding their enrolment status.
