



Instrumental Music Program 2026



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC SCHEDULE

Lessons will be provided during College hours, unless negotiated with the tutor in advance and approved by the Music Department. Students will be withdrawn from class during the College day on a rotating timetable, to ensure that the same class is not missed each week. Timetables are printed and given to students, this should be glued into their student diary. Some changes to timetables may occur due to College examinations or excursions.

INSTRUMENT HIRE



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC - TERMS AND CONDITIONS



1. Lesson Procedures

Lessons are 30 minutes in duration and may be taken individually or in groups (2-4 students). P-2 students will be collected from class by the tutor and walked directly to and from the lesson. Year 3-6 students will be called from their classroom at their allocated lesson time. MYSY students should ensure they turn up to their pre-arranged lesson on time. Lessons are located at the Spoleto Music block and will mostly be provided during college hours, unless negotiated with the tutor in advance. Students will be withdrawn from class during school hours, unless an alternative time has been negotiated with the instrumental tutor. Some changes to lesson times may be required due to College examinations or excursions.

2. Cost and Payment of Lessons

Individual tutors will provide families with a term invoice and full payment is required for the term prior to the commencement of lessons for that period. Failure to pay invoices in time may result in your child losing their spot in the program.

Individual Lessons	\$425 per term
Group Lessons (2-4 students)	\$250 per term

3. Missed Lessons

Students are required to give their instrumental teacher a minimum of 24 hours notice if they cannot attend a scheduled lesson. This includes school events such as excursions, exams, sport carnivals, as well as personal circumstances such as dental appointments etc. If the appropriate notice is given, the lesson will be rescheduled by the tutor. Unaccounted absences and unexplained missed lessons will incur the normal lesson fee and will not be rescheduled.

4. Termination of Lessons

Once the enrolment process is completed, enrolment will be for the remainder of the school year. Withdrawal from lessons must be in writing to the music department instrumental@assisi.qld.edu.au and can only be allowed at the end of a term.

5. Equipment Requirements

Parents may be required to purchase a display folder and/or other specific materials for lessons. Instrumental teachers will be in communication directly to arrange the purchase/hire of any necessary equipment.
